Students who have completed the Diploma in International Relations with Merit or Distinction are encouraged to apply for the Higher Diploma Programme.

How to Apply

- Download and print the application from BCIS website (www.bcis.edu.lk) or collect from the BCIS Information Desk.
- Completed applications to be submitted along with certified copies of the following documents:
 - ✓ Certificate of Birth
 - ✓ National Identity Card
 - ✓ Educational Qualifications
 - ✓ Professional Qualifications
 - ✓ Service certificates (only if applicable) &
 - ✓ Two (02) stamp-sized (2cm x 2cm) colour photographs
- A registration fee of Rs. 1000/= (non-refundable) and the relevant course fee to be paid to the BCIS. Cheques should be drawn in favour of **SWRD Memorial Foundation Fund (BCIS)**.

Registration Fees

- o If a student registers for an IR programme and then within a year wants to register for another IR programme, he/she must pay the Registration Fee a second time.
- o If a student registers for an IR programme and also wants to register for a Language programme, he/she would have to pay two Registration Fees.

Transferring from one course to another

- o Once a student registers for an IR programme and then changes their decision and wants to transfer to a Language programme, it cannot be allowed. The relevant Refund Policy would apply.
- o Transfers may be done within the IR programme, within a year of registration, in keeping with their qualifications.
