Certificate Course in International Relations



DURATION
3 months

- TARGET GROUPS** : Individuals who wish to gain an elementary knowledge on International Relations and Diplomacy.
- PREREQUISITES** : Successful completion of G.C.E. O/L examination.
- COURSE HIGHLIGHTS** : Provides a basic knowledge on International Relations.



Diploma Course in International Relations



DURATION
6 months

- TARGET GROUPS** : Individuals with experience in the fields of International Relations, Diplomacy, International Trade, Tourism, Media, Law and officers of Armed forces.
- PREREQUISITES** : Undergraduates at a recognized university/minimum 5 years work experience at a recognized organization related to International Relations, International Trade, Tourism, Media, Law and officers of Armed forces/ successful completion of G.C.E. A/L examination/ Completion of BCIS Certificate course in International Relations with Merit or Distinction.
- COURSE HIGHLIGHTS** : This programme provides an overview on theories of International Relations and introduces an array of Interdisciplinary subjects.



Higher Diploma in International Relations



DURATION
12 months

- TARGET GROUPS** : Individuals engaged in International Relations, Diplomacy, International Trade, Tourism, Media, Law and officers of Armed forces.
- PREREQUISITES** : A Degree from a recognized University or equivalent professional qualification / Minimum of 10 years work experience in a recognized organization related to International Relations, International Trade, tourism, Media, Law and officers of Armed forces / Completion of BCIS Diploma Course in International Relations with Merit or Distinction.
- COURSE HIGHLIGHTS** : This programme provides theoretical knowledge on principles of International Relations. Critical evaluation, debate and discussion are encouraged.



Postgraduate Diploma in International Relations



DURATION
18 months

- TARGET GROUPS** : Advanced learners of International Relations and/or with professional experience in fields related to International Relations and Diplomacy.
- PREREQUISITES** : A Degree from a recognized university or equivalent professional qualification. Preference will be given to those having pursued studies in International Relations.
- COURSE HIGHLIGHTS** : This programme provides an expansive, intellectual and academic framework to understand International Relations. Participants are expected to conduct a research and write a dissertation related to International Relations.
