How to Apply

- Download and print the application from BCIS website (<u>www.bcis.edu.lk</u>) or collect from the BCIS Information Desk.
- Completed applications to be submitted along with <u>certified</u> (from a JP or Lawyer) copies of the following documents:
 - ✓ Certificate of Birth
 - ✓ National Identity Card
 - ✓ Educational Qualifications
 - ✓ Professional Qualifications
 - ✓ Service certificates (only if applicable) &
 - ✓ One (01) passport-sized colour photograph

*Please note that you cannot register for the course if you do not have all of the above documents.

• The registration fee is <u>non-refundable</u>. Cheques should be drawn in favour of **SWRD** Memorial Foundation Fund (BCIS).

Registration Fees

- If a student registers for an IR programme and then within a year wants to register for another IR programme, he/she must pay the Registration Fee a second time.
- If a student registers for an IR programme and also wants to register for a Language programme, he/she would have to pay two Registration Fees.

Transferring from one course to another

- Once a student registers for an IR programme and then changes their decision and wants to transfer to a Language programme, it cannot be allowed. The relevant Refund Policy would apply.
- Transfers may be done within the IR programme, within a year of registration, in keeping with their qualifications.
